RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF MEDICAL CANNABIS OPERATIONS WITHIN BULLOCK COUNTY

WHEREAS, on may 17, 2021, the Governor for the State of Alabama signed Darren Wesley 'Ato' Hall Compassion Act into law (the Act); and

WHEREAS, the Act provides for the medical use of marijuana for patients with a qualifying medical condition and a valid medical cannabis card; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the Medical Cannabis Commission to regulate medical cannabis operations, (See, 20-2A-22, Code of Alabama), thus addressing any health, safety, or welfare concerns for the citizens of Bullock County; and

WHEREAS, the location of a medical cannabis operation within Bullock County will bring the potential of hundreds of new employment opportunities for the citizens of Bullock County; and

WHEREAS, any medical cannabis operation would be required to comply with all current and future tax requirements to Bullock County, thus increasing revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF BULLOCK COUNTY, ALABAMA, that it authorizes the operation of medical cannabis operations within Bullock County.
