

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF MEDICAL CANNABIS
OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF UNION SPRINGS

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2021, the Governor for the State of Alabama signed Darren Wesley 'Ato' Hall Compassion Act into law (the Act); and

WHEREAS, the Act provides for the medical use of marijuana for patients with a qualifying medical condition and a valid medical cannabis card; and

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the Medical Cannabis Commission to regulate medical cannabis operations, (See, 20-2A-22, Code of Alabama), thus addressing any health, safety, or welfare concerns for the citizens of Union Springs; and


WHEREAS, the location of a medical cannabis operation within the corporate limits of Union Springs will bring the potential of hundreds of new employment opportunities for the citizens of Union Springs; and

WHEREAS, any medical cannabis operation would be required to comply with all current and future tax requirements to Union Springs, thus increasing revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF UNION SPRINGS, ALABAMA, that it authorizes the operation of medical cannabis operations within the corporate limits of Union Springs.
