AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF MEDICAL CANNABIS DISPENSING SITES IN
THE UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF DALLAS COUNTY

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

December 21, 2022

THAT WHEREAS, in its 2022 session, the Alabama Legislature adopted the Darren Wesley "Ato" Hall Compassion Act (hereinafter "Act"), which has been codified in the Code of Alabama as Section 20-2A-1 and which provides for the cultivation, processing, transporting, testing and dispensing of medical cannabis in accord with the provisions of the Act and the regulations adopted with respect thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Dallas County Commission has been requested by a potential applicant for a license under the Act authorizing the operation of a dispensing site for medical cannabis within the unincorporated areas of Dallas County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Dallas County Commission does hereby authorize the operation of medical cannabis dispensing sites within the unincorporated areas of the county pursuant to the provisions of Ala. Code § 20-2A-51(c)(2) and the further provisions of the Act as set out in Ala. Code 20-2A-1, et seq., and the regulations which have been adopted with respect thereto, and pursuant to which medical cannabis may only be dispensed by a licensee of the Alabama Medical Cannabis Commission and to patients and caregivers who meet the qualifications of the applicable statutes and regulations.
